ROBIN L. TURNER BIOGRAPHY

Robin Turner began his career with the Disney Corp. after growing up in Orlando. With this grounding in the world of large attractions and tourism, he successfully created and built a special event and fair/attraction management company, the first of its kind in the United States. The company is now one of the leading consultants in planning, developing and operating state and local fairs.

In 1997, Mr. Turner founded Attraction Concepts, Ltd., which established the highly successful WonderWorks attraction at Pointe Orlando. This science education and entertainment complex attracts millions of visitors annually and is a popular field trip for schools throughout Florida. Attraction Concepts will open a second WonderWorks in Pigeon Forge, Tenn., in May of 2006.

In 1999, Mr. Turner founded the Community Bank of the South and currently serves on its board of directors. He also has served as the treasurer of the Florida State Fair Authority.

Having grown up vacationing in the Great Smoky Mountains National Park, as well as having had an avid interest in residential real estate (he has purchased mountain property in North Carolina and acreage in Florida), Mr. Turner and his family moved to Gatlinburg, Tenn., in 2005 to develop the Estates at Norton Creek. The Estates at Norton Creek is one of the most beautiful and last privately-owned tracts of land adjacent to a national park in the eastern United States. It will serve as a mountain community for those looking to build second, retirement or vacation homes.
